Thoughts and Tips for Obtaining Sponsorships

- 1. All businesses have a projected budget for the year usually in the form of a pie chart. A piece of the pie chart is for donating to charities as it promotes their business and provides them with tax deductions. They expect to be asked for donations, so lets go get a piece of the pie.
- 2. Wear your Zonta shirt and nametag it helps make you look official.
- 3. It works well to go with one of your team members.
- 4. Start by introducing yourself and say a one liner as to what Zonta is about such as, "We are group professional women dedicated to improving many circumstances of women in all stages of life.
- 5. Let them know their donation will aid Zonta to provide many service projects in Miami Lakes and Miami Dade communities.
- 6. Show the Ad which is place in the <u>Miami Laker</u> and the <u>place card that in your packet</u>, so they will see how their business will be recognized.
- 7. Remember we are now a 501 c.3 organization and our number is at the bottom of the thank you letter and the sponsorship letter included in your packet. The Thank You letter is to be given to those who request a receipt.
- 8. It is important to obtain the correct spelling and wording on the sponsorship form as it will appear on our printed material as stated on the form.
- 9. Do not miss asking for a donation from anyone that you do business with. One member said, "Every time I write a check, I get a check."
- 10. We should not have a restaurant in Miami Lakes or Pembroke Pines that we do not have a gift card from. When dining out ask to waiter to see the manager. Let him/her know that we are going to have a dine-around basket for the Silent Auction at our Claws for Celebration funding raising dinner. Add that you want to give them the opportunity for their restaurant to be a part of that basket.
- 11. Look for new businesses in our area welcome them to Miami Lakes and thank them for choosing our community. A member got a \$500 gift basket by doing this.
- 12. Look at the list of businesses that donated last year and think of businesses that are similar to past donors but haven't given a donation and approach them. Example, we obtained a donation from Winn Dixie by showing the place card from last year and pointing out that Publix donated and said that we prefer shopping at Winn Dixie and would also like to see their name on our place card and in our thank you ad this year. Without a moment hesitation the manager gave us \$100!

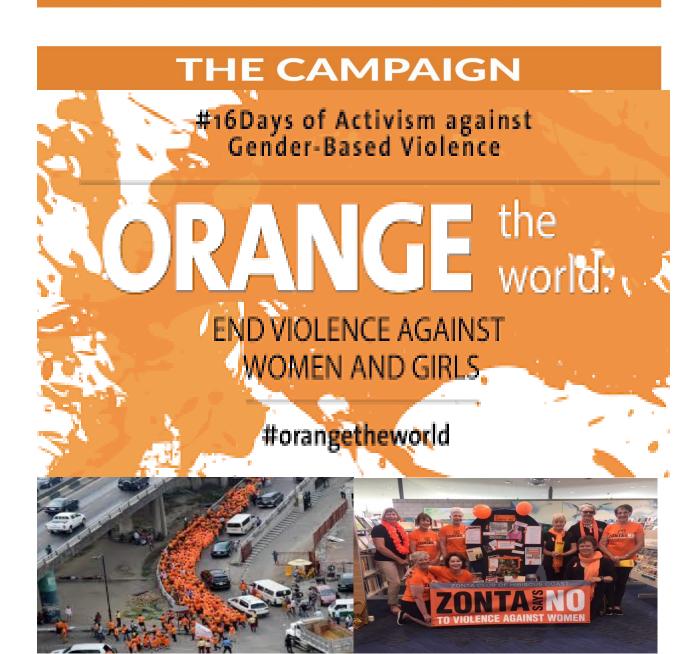

ZONTAS NO TO VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN





Dear Zontians,

In the four minutes it takes you to read this letter, almost 100 girls under the age of 18 will be forced into a marriage.

We know the data. Globally, nearly 650 million girls and women alive today were married as children, and COVID-19 and school closures have put an additional 10 million girls at risk of becoming child brides before the end of the decade. No matter how many ways we look at the data, one fact remains: a key way to keep girls out of early and forced marriages is to keep them in school. Every year that a girl remains in secondary school her chances of not entering an early or forced marriage drops by six percent.



In July of this year, <u>Girls Not Brides released a thematic brief</u>, <u>Girls Education and Child Marriage</u> that explains the very delicate relationship between the two. The report states: The relationship between child marriage and girls' education works both ways. Decisions around them are complex and influenced by a variety of factors. For example, a girl may drop out of school for an unrelated reason and then find marriage is the only option open to her; or the decision for her to get married may force her to drop out of school.

There is no easy solution to this problem, and we know it will take long-term, concerted efforts to end this harmful practice. Through our support of the Global Programme to End Child Marriage and actions at the national, state and local levels, we are making a difference. Please know your support for the Programme is already changing minds and lives.

Our Zonta Says NO campaign is another great opportunity to raise awareness of the issue of child marriage. I am looking forward to seeing how you are saying NO to violence against women and girls. Follow Zonta on social media channels and bookmark ZontaSaysNO.com to see the actions that our clubs are taking. Be proud of your

work and the strength you bring to empower our fellow women and girls.

It has been about four minutes. Through Zonta I know we are going to help the next 100 girls!
